About Rod Handley

Rod Handley is the Founder and President of Character That Counts, a ministry that was established in July 2000. It is based in Lee's Summit, MO which is on the southeast corner of Kansas City.

He served as Senior Vice President and Chief Operating Officer/Chief Financial Officer for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) until his departure in June 2000. Rod worked for FCA since 1986, initially serving in Seattle as the Assistant State Director for Washington. He moved to Kansas City in 1989 to work at the FCA National Headquarters.

Rod has over 25 published books including, *Character Counts-Who's Counting Yours?* which details how to begin the process of being accountable to one another. The book is a practical tool for helping people who desire to be people of character and integrity. The latest version of this book was released in 2012. *Character Counts, Volume 1, 2 & 3* came out in 2001-2004. *Life in View of Eternity*, published in 2010 contains numerous character lessons. Numerous projects for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes have been developed including: *One Way 2 Play* (2002); *Team Studies on Character, Volumes 1-7* (2004-2010); *GAMECHANGER* (2011); *IN THE ZONE* (2012); *Called to Compete* (2012); *RELENTLESS* (2013); *ALL IN* (2014); *UNDEFEATED* (2015); *RISE* (2016); *ONE* (2017); *STRONG* (2018) and *LET'S GO* (2019). He is also one of 45 contributing authors for *How To Disciple Men* (2017) and he co-wrote *No Regrets. No Retreats. No Reserves* (2018).

In addition, he is a popular retreat and banquet speaker with men's and women's groups, singles and married. Rod averages over 250 speaking engagements each year, proclaiming the Good News of Jesus Christ, with all ages. He has been a speaker for Christian Management Association, Stonecroft-Christian Women's Club, Gospel Rescue Missions, The Gathering of Men, The National Coalition of Men's Ministries, Pro Athletes Outreach, Young Life, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Lifeway, Iron Sharpens Iron Men's Conferences, Promise Keepers, Men of Valor, numerous public and private schools, churches and corporations. Over the past 35+ years, Rod has spoken at a number of colleges and universities across America and countless high school and junior high assembly programs.

He's done numerous chapel programs for high school, collegiate and professional teams over the past 35 years including: Nebraska Cornhuskers, Florida State Seminoles, Missouri Tigers, Liberty University, San Diego Chargers, Tampa Bay Buccaneers, Detroit Lions, Kansas City Chiefs, St. Louis Rams, Denver Broncos, Kansas City Royals, Texas Rangers, Detroit Tigers, Seattle Mariners, Anaheim Angels, Tampa Bay Devil Rays, Cleveland Indians and Orlando Magic. He is an ordained minister and served as the chaplain for the Seattle SuperSonics (1986-89). He led the Kansas City Royals Bible Study many years.

Rod co-founded TGIW (Teaching Guys Infinite Wisdom) in September 2001 and today this ministry reaches a number of communities and churches around the nation. Rod serves on the board of AFA-KS & MO and Priority Advantage. He and his family are actively involved with a number of rescue missions.

A graduate of Central Washington University, Rod was a 4-year letterman and starter on the football team, and earned Academic All-American honors during his senior year. He also earned his CPA license while working for Ernst and Whinney, prior to joining FCA. Rod and his wife, Janna, have four children, Brooke (25), Derek (24) & his wife Mikala, Jake (22) and Trent (18) and reside in Lee's Summit, Missouri. Rod & Janna are ministry leaders at their home church (Abundant Life) in Lee's Summit, MO.
