3 features that help us see the importance of Jesus as our Great High Priest:

I. The _____ for Jesus' Priesthood (9.1, 6-10)

They serve a copy and shadow of the heavenly things. For when Moses was about to erect the tent, he was instructed by God, saying, "See that you make everything according to the pattern that was shown you on the mountain." (8.5)

III. The _____ of Jesus' Priesthood (4.14-16, 7.23-27, 10.11-14).

Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. (4.16)

Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them. (7.25)
